

Mentor Night Details

Starting on Thursday 21 of April and every other 3rd Thursday of each month we will hold a mentor session at TBC. at 7PM to 9 PM. The likely format is 3 or 4 students at a table with the mentor either sitting in or watching from the side-line.

You will play the hand, turn the cards face up and conduct a thorough debrief of that hand. This is when find out "Oh yes you should have returned partners suit back" or "Maybe we could have been more competitive in the bidding"

Although mentoring isn't about complicated bidding systems, the mentor can point out when the time is right, how "Cue Raises" or "4th Suit Forcing" might have solved a bidding problem better. This way you can see in context exactly how a gadget can work for you. When you understand the rationale behind things they tend to stick better in your mind.
